It featured in the film 'Agatha' with Vanessa Redgrave and Dustin Hoffman. In 2021, Cygnus was reimagined by filmmaker Wes Anderson. The new look features stunning symmetrical marquetry, bold rectilinear shapes and a visual feast of complementary colours.
- Dining onboard is pure indulgence, with seasonal dishes crafted by expert chefs and served elegantly by liveried stewards, complemented by fine wines and champagnes.



Upon arrival at Machu Picchu Pueblo station, enjoy a welcome cocktail and exclusive access to a private waiting room. Once back on board the train, dine in style in the Restaurant Car with a specially prepared dinner, accompanied by live music onboard for an unforgettable experience.
